Being that it is now November, I have sent out invoices to any of you for whom I have done work in October, or for those who have not yet paid for previous months. Please remit your payment when you have a chance.

Domain Name vs. Hosting - I have discussed this with a number of you individually and I think it is worth explaining here. These 2 entities are totally separate and the analogy I generally use is like buying a plot of land for a home. The domain name is like the land. It is important, but you can't live there until you have a house built on it. The house, in my example, is the actual website containing text, images, links, etc. For a number of clients, I have found that you purchased the domain name from one company and the hosting from another. When I create a website from scratch, I generally use the same company for both services. This is easier for a number of reasons, First, since both are purchased at the same time, they both will expire at the same time. There has been confusion in the past, as people have told me that their website has expired and I do not know initially which part they are talking about. In addition, the company I most often deal with has a deal where, if you prepay for the hosting, they offer the domain name for free. In addition, if you have any more time left on the domain name, they add it on to the end of the period of the hosting, so you do not lose it. This then makes the expiration dates different, but you don't lose the time you have already paid for.

<u>Confusion</u> - There seems to be some confusion regarding the invoices I have been sending out. The template I am using has a macro in it that displays the current date. As a result, whenever you would open up the invoice it would show the date when you opened it. I have fixed that and there are now 2 dates that display, the current date and the date I sent the invoice to you.
