There are numerous software packages out there, some for free and some you have to pay for. It has been my personal experience that there is not much difference between free ones and paid ones and, in fact, I have had more problems with the ones you have to pay for than the ones you can get for free. The 2 largest free ones out there right now are AVG and Avast. I have tried both and I would recommend either one. They both work well for files, emails, etc. Each one also offers a paid version with a few more bells and whistles. Whether it is worth it to pay for the "Pro" or "Advanced" versions is subject to debate. What is definitely NOT subject to debate is whether or not to have some form of anti-virus protection. You need something and you need to make sure it is updated regularly. There are settings to update automatically and you should probably do it daily. I have mine set to update every night at 2 AM, so my virus database is always current.

Note that these are different than the other "spyware" or "malware" software solutions I have discussed in past newsletters.

<u>Search Engine Placement</u> – For most people, getting on the first page of the search engines is the goal.
