<u>Multimedia</u> – Lately there have been a number of reports about web multi-media software being hacked. Internet Explorer, Firefox, Flash, Adobe Reader and Acrobat, among others, have been the victims of malicious attacks (commonly called "malware"). And with the proliferation of multi-media on the internet, it makes you a little wary when you are out there "surfing". Unfortunately, it always seems to be the "big boys". Microsoft, Macromedia which now is combined with Adobe, etc. are the companies these hackers concentrate on, since they are the ones that most people use. I have found a few pieces of free software you may want to try in their place.

Long Tail Video – This company produces all kinds of audio and video player software. You can download slideshow players for images, audio players for .mp3 sound files and video players for most, if not all, video formats (Windows Media, Flash, etc.). There are paid versions where you get more "bells and whistles", tech support, etc. but, if you have any technical expertise, you can work with the free versions pretty easily. There are numerous plug-ins and different kinds of "skins" you can apply to change the look of the player. There are parameters to control volume, size, auto-play and on and on. You have access to documentation on their website and I have had much success with them. <u>Jquery</u> – I subscribe to a number of web newsletters and I recently came upon a couple of pretty cool slideshow solutions and I thought I would share at least one of them. A little bit of background first...

People have created libraries of "canned" packages containing JavaScript routines to perform various features and Jquery is one of them.
